

PROPOSED WORKS IN YOUR AREA - Hains Lane Marnhull

Dear Sir/Madam

Dorset Council are continuing to maintain and invest in Dorset's highway network. In recognition of the current pandemic, additional safety measures are also being taken to ensure the health and safety of workers in these unprecedented times. We are working closely with other highway authorities across the south west and with industry bodies to share knowledge of new ways of working. As you can appreciate this is a rapidly developing situation, so we are doing our best to keep Dorset's businesses and residents up to date as work progresses. To enable us to carry out rescheduled Insitu surface treatment work, we plan to close Hains Lane Marnhull between 4th and 14th April 2022. The closure will be in place 24 hours per day. During the closure periods there will be no on street parking available. Parking restrictions will be imposed to prevent waiting or parking on the roads stated above. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986. If a vehicle has been towed the owner will need to contact our towing contractors Bride Valley on 01305 889421.

We will be repairing sections of road within the area marked in red indicated on the map. The diversion route is marked in blue. National regulations state that we have to divert traffic onto the same classification of road as the one we have closed. Vehicular and pedestrian access will be maintained for residents, however there may be a time where they are asked to wait depending on the current activity on site.

An allowance for school transport can be made. If you could please provide us by return email the registrations and time periods of which vehicles could pass through the closure, we will endeavour to accommodate your requirements.

We will contact you again nearer the time to confirm the dates of the work and the closure needed.
